

Signing Up With Authorize.net

PPV customers will need to create an account with Authorize.net to process the transactions that take place within their player. ClickStreamTV does not handle any transactions so it is mandatory to work with a clearing house.

Step One:

Visit <http://www.authorize.net> to begin. Authorize.net works with several financial institutions so follow the instructions on screen to create an account with a bank in your area.

Step Two:

Once you've created an account, you will need to provide two pieces of information to ClickStreamTV:

- Authorize.net Login ID
- Authorize.net Transaction Key

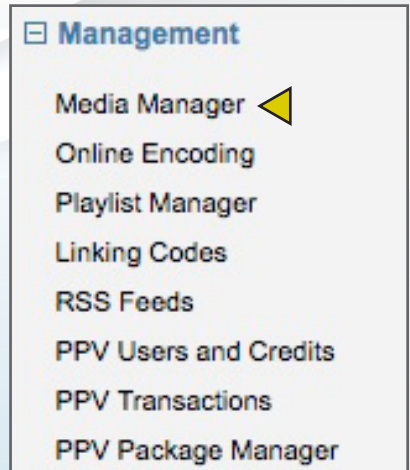
Changing Prices

Step One:

Log into the ClickStreamTV Media Control Center (<http://mcc.clickstreamtv.net/mcc/auth/>).

Step Two:

Select "Management" from the menu on the left hand side of the page. Then click on "Media Manager." A list of all your current videos will appear.



Step Three:

Select the video whose price you would like to change and click on the thumbnail for that video.

Step Four:

To change the price, enter a new amount for the video and then click "Submit." Once submitted, your changes will be applied to all future transactions.

Viewing Users and Transactions

Step One:

Log into the ClickStreamTV Media Control Center <http://mcc.clickstreamtv.net/mcc/auth/>

Step Two:

From the menu on the left, select "Management," and then choose either "PPV Users and Credits" or "PPV Transactions."

Step Three:

"PPV Users and Credits" will take you to a list of current users, their login information, and their credits (if applicable) and purchases. From this menu you can delete users or select "View Sessions" for an in-depth look at individual purchase history.

Step Four:

Selecting "PPV Transactions" will give you a breakdown of how many times a video has been purchased, as well as the number of purchases made using your PPV Player.
